- 1. The papers for this item were presented by Neelam Sood, HFEA Inspector. Dr Sood informed the Committee that this centre is part of a large NHS Trust and carries out both NHS and self-funded treatments. The centre was established in 1992 and has a good history of regulatory compliance. The centre is awaiting a major refurbishment to take place next year.
- 2. Dr Sood informed the Committee that the most significant problem identified at the inspection was the lack of privacy for patients undergoing ultrasound examinations. The Committee noted that present arrangements are not ideal and noted that the centre's plans for an upgrade should address this. In the meantime, however, the Committee requested that the centre reviews the problem in consultation with Dr Sood.
- 3. Dr Sood informed the Committee that the risk assessment she has carried out on the centre indicates an 16% risk, placing the centre amongst the lowest scoring centres.

4. Taking into account the forthcoming refurbishment the Committee agreed to renew the centre's licence for a period of three years, with no additional conditions.
