Centre 0250 - (Glasgow Centre for Reproductive Medicine) – Variation of Licence to include embryo biopsy

Consideration of Application

1. The Panel noted this item consisted of a desk-based assessment report including PR's response, an application form and previous licensing minutes for the past three years.
2. The Panel noted that this centre was initially granted a licence for treatment and storage on 1 November 2006 and provides treatment to self-funded and NHS patients.
3. The Panel noted that this centre has applied to vary its licence on 10 April 2012 to add embryo testing and, thereby, to change from a treatment and storage centre to a treatment and storage centre (including embryo testing).
4. The Panel noted that this centre is intending to offer preimplantation genetic screening (PGS) as part of its embryo testing programme.
5. The Panel noted the assessment carried out by the Inspectorate and that the Inspectorate was satisfied it had the correct documentation as required by General Direction 0008 to provide evidence of the validation of embryo biopsy processes.
6. The Panel noted the Inspectorate's recommendation to vary the centre's licence to add embryo testing.

Decision

7. The Panel agreed to vary the centre's licence to add embryo testing and, thereby, to change the licence to treatment and storage (including embryo testing), in accordance with Section 18A of the HFE Act 1990 (as amended).
