1. Consideration of application

- 1.1. The panel considered the papers, which included a completed application form, an executive summary, previous licensing minutes, a CV and confirmation of acceptance from the proposed Person Responsible (PR).
- 1.2. The panel noted that the proposed PR, Mrs Sarah Reddish, is willing to assume the responsibility of the role of PR. The panel noted that the proposed PR has satisfactorily completed the PR Entry Programme (PREP) and the certificate number was provided.
- 1.3. The panel noted Mrs Sarah Reddish has suitable qualifications for the role of PR.
- 1.4. The panel noted from the information provided that the character, qualifications and experience of the proposed PR are suitable to carry out a PR's duties under section 17 of the HFE Act 1990 (as amended).
- 1.5. The panel noted that all information required under General Directions 0008 has been provided.
- 1.6. The panel noted assurance had been provided that recommendations for improvement, made at the time of the last inspection, had been fully implemented.
- 1.7. The panel noted the inspectorate's recommendation to vary the centre's licence to appoint Mrs Sarah Reddish as the PR.

- 2.1. The panel agreed it was in receipt of the appropriate documentation as required by the HFE Act 1990 (as amended) in relation to Section 16(2), which sets out the requirements with regard to the role of Licence Holder and Person Responsible.
