1. Consideration of application

- 1.1.** The Licensing Officer considered the papers, which included a completed application form, an executive summary, and confirmation of acceptance from the proposed new Licence Holder (LH).
- 1.2.** The Licensing Officer noted that Mr Steve Cumley is willing to assume the responsibility of the role of LH.
- 1.3.** The Licensing Officer noted that all information required under General Directions 0008 had been provided.
