1. Consideration of Application

- 1.1.** The Licensing Officer noted that the name is presently **CARE Fertility Birmingham** and the centre now wishes to be known as **CARE Birmingham**. The Person Responsible (PR) has therefore submitted an application to rename the centre.
- 1.2.** The Licensing Officer noted the inspectorate's recommendation to approve the variation of licence to change the centre's name.
- 1.3.** The Licensing Officer noted that the centre has been issued with an Importing Tissue Establishment (ITE) importing certificate, pursuant to the Human Fertilisation and Embryology (Amendment) Regulations 2018. If this application is approved, the centre's ITE certificate should be amended to reflect the new centre name.


2. Decision

- 2.1.** After considering the recommendation of the inspectorate and all supporting documentation, the Licensing Officer changed the name of the centre to **CARE Birmingham**.
